



I – THE LIFE AND LEGACY OF WALTER B. ARNOLD, JR.

Walter B. Arnold Jr. admired the creativity, dreams and accomplishments of our community's youth and wanted to recognize and reward these talented young people. His community service brought him to The Fair where he joined the Board of Directors and served an amazing 41 years. He served as The Fair's president, secretary, treasurer and general manager. He was named Fair Person of the Year by the Florida Federation of Fairs and was recognized throughout Florida for helping build the state's fair industry.

Arnold lived by his philosophy: *"We were born into this world without paying for a whole lot of things. Our payment can be what we do for other people."* He was devoted to youth programs, community service and the celebration and recognition of young achievers.

In 2001, The Miami-Dade County Fair & Exposition Board of Directors officially established the Youth Hall of Fame Community Service Award to honor the vision and dream of Walter B. Arnold, Jr.

II – APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

1. The entry form must be typewritten using a 12-point font.
2. School and/or community service must be documented on the service log provided. Format and headings may not be changed or altered. Please begin with the most recent dates.
3. You are allowed 5 pages of support documents (i.e., letters, awards, and news clippings) in addition to the application form.
4. Two letters of recommendation must be included in the application: one letter from your school (i.e., principal or head administrator, guidance counselor, or teacher) and one letter from the person who supervised or directed your major service project.
5. Submit six copies (the typed original and five photocopies) of the application form.
6. **Project must be from current year.**
7. Applications must be submitted to the designated person at your school. One school finalist is to be submitted by your school coordinator by Friday, March 8, 2024, to Ms. Carol Douglass, Exhibits Director, THE FAIR, 10901 Coral Way, Miami, Florida 33165. 8. Finalists from previous years may not submit the same project.
9. Open to all middle and high school students in public, private, parochial and home schools in grades 6 - 12.
10. Applications are for individual entries only.
